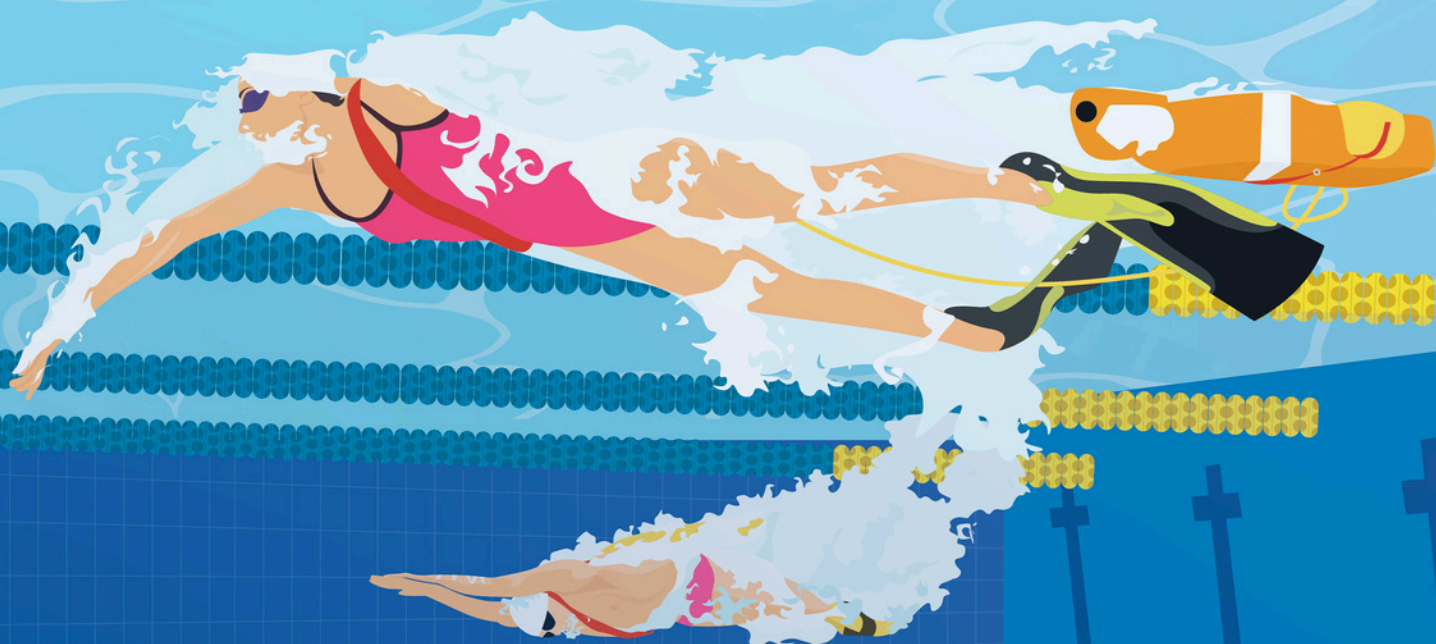

01 THE FFSS



The Fédération Française de Sauvetage et de Secourisme, founded in 1899 by Raymond Pitet, is an association under the French law of 1901, recognized as a public utility since 1927. It includes associations whose purpose is to organize and promote first aid and lifesaving sports.

The FFSS is recognized by the Ministry of the Interior as a public interest organization for training in first aid, and by the Sports Ministry for the promotion and development of lifesaving sport.

The main areas of activity are :

Under the authority of the Ministry of the Interior, for :

FIRST-AID TRAINING

The federation is authorized to provide training for the general public (GQS, PSC, etc.), as well as professional and lifesaving training. The 400 structures are available to provide training in all areas of land and water for the general public and professionals alike.

CIVIL SECURITY MISSIONS

The FFSS, an approved Civil Security association, is involved in all Civil Security missions throughout France. It has human and material resources available to come to the aid or assistance of the population.

LIFE SAVING

Lifesaving is a practice imported from Australia and known as "SURF LIFE SAVING" and it is a recognized high-level discipline.

03 THE MEETING

The French Meeting International organized by A3S is open to lifesavers in the **Youth and Open** categories who are members of a club affiliated to the F.F.S.S., as well as to foreign clubs and nations.

The competition will take place at the **Centre Aquatique Camille Muffat** in Aubervilliers, on **January 18 and 19, 2025**.

The competition is a **qualifier for the next World Games**, to be held **August 7-9, 2025** in Chengdu, China. It is also a qualifier for the **French flatwater championships**.

It includes all **individual events**:

200m Super Lifesaver, 100m Rescue Medley, 100m Manikin Carry with Fins, 100m Manikin Tow with Fins, 50m Manikin Carry and the Golden Course.

As well as the **team events**:

4x25m Manikin Relay, 4x50m Medley Relay, 4X50m Pool LifeSaver Relay

*And a **brand-new race formula** exclusive to the competition:*

The French Meeting International is introducing a unique format for the 50m manikin : The **GOLDEN COURSE**

In this event, only the eight best lifesavers (8 men and 8 women), selected from among the competitors in the classic 50m manikin, will have the chance to compete in a knockout competition.

THE CONCEPT: 8 LIFESAVERS AT THE START... ONLY ONE WINNER!

The lifesavers will compete in three successive races, with 15 to 20 minutes of recovery time between each heat. The first race will see all 8 participants set off, but only 4 will continue the adventure. After that, only 2 will compete in the final for victory and the prize money.

Who will take the top step of the podium?



04 THE VENUE

The international French meeting will be at the Camille Muffat aquatic center in Aubervilliers. It was inaugurated on November 6.

Equipped with two 50m and 25m sports pools, of modular width, with a movable floor to vary depth, and a leisure pool.

To enhance performance and allow qualification for world games, the pool depth will be a constant 2m.

The pool is part of the Seine-Saint-Denis department's Olympic heritage. This summer, it hosted training sessions for the Olympic water polo delegations for Paris 2024.

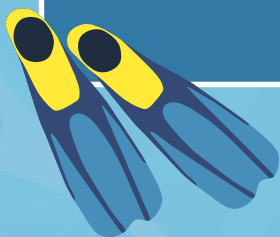

06 MEETING RULES

RULES in ILS format

*Qualifying competition for the World Games
and the French Flatwater Championships.*

CATEGORIES

YOUTH / OPEN = individual events

OPEN = relay events

UPGRADE

People born between 2011 and 2012 cannot be upgraded to youth.

Youth can take part in open events, but will not be able to compete in any events in their category.

SELECTION

Competition open to all F.F.S.S. licensees and foreign clubs and nations.

Foreign clubs and nations must request a registration link directly from:
sport@ffss.fr

REWARDS

Individuals : medals for the top three men and women in the Open and Youth categories in each event.

Relays: medals for the first three men's and women's relays in the Open category in each event.

GOLDEN COURSE : prize money for first place -2000€ divided between the men's and women's podiums.
a gift for second and third place.

COMMITMENT FEE

Entry fees are 5 euros per individual event.

Entry fees will be calculated at the time of registration, and must be paid in the reserved area in order to be taken into account before registration closes.

Forfeits made after the startlist has been published will not be returned.

Entry period: until 10/01/2025

RACE COMMITTEE

It will take place the day before the first race at 7.30pm.

The technical meeting will take place in the pool's Oasis area. A videoconference link will be provided.

Jury composition will be made in accordance with FFSS rules.
